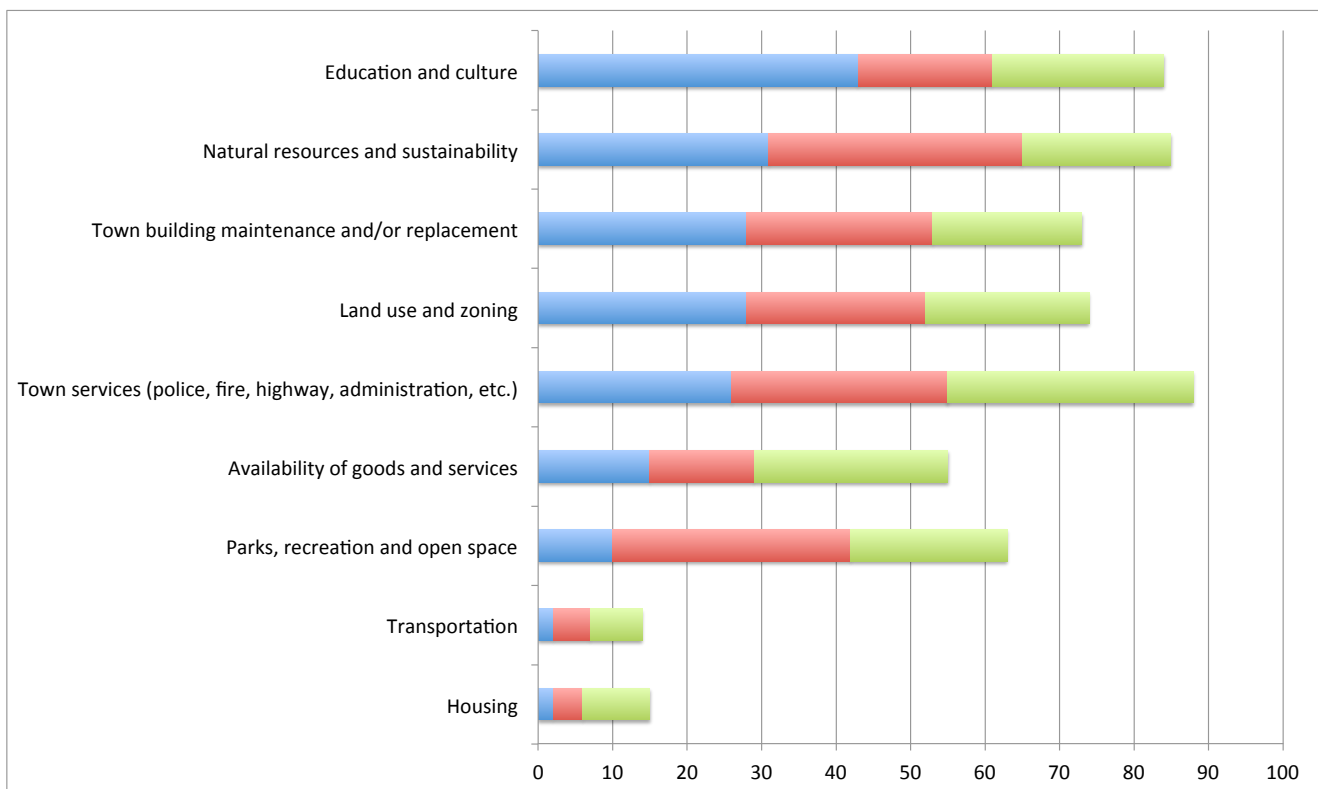

Per #8 we need more modest single family houses capes and ranches vs mini mansions

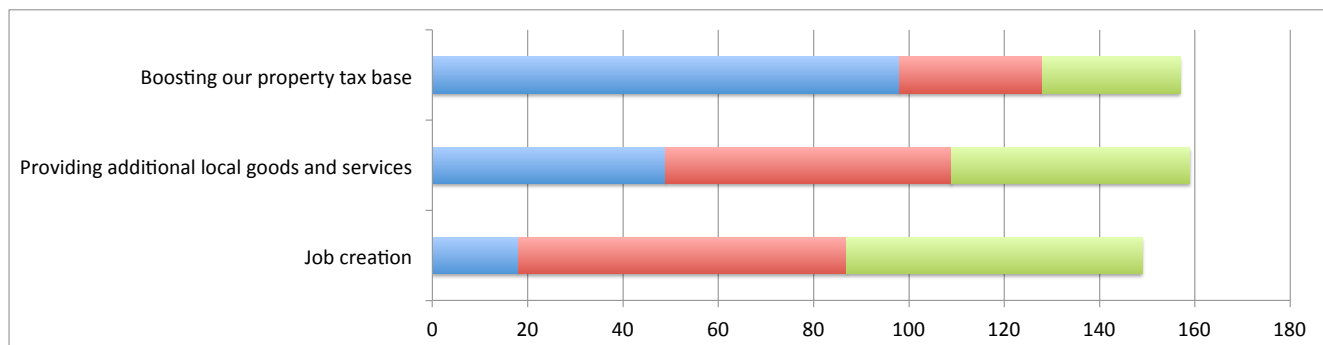
Making the town turn into seekonk or taunton - for the next question, no housing developments are needed. Especially not senior housing or assisted living facilities.
